7. Player #1 gets a final turn to unwrap the last gift or steal a gift from another player who will then get the remaining unwrapped gift.

Note: Each gift can only be stolen three times in the game.

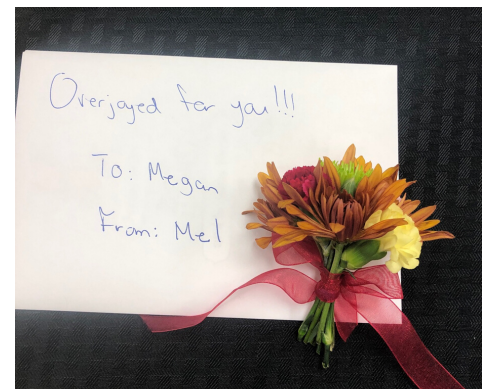
Thanks to all of our members who shared pictures of their new teachers receiving the flower arrangements we made. This was definitely a nice way to let them know that they are doing a great job!
