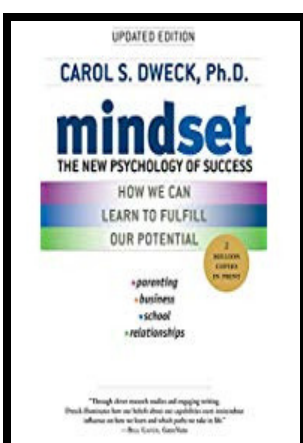
Fall Food Demonstration
